MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In 2022, Cause We Care expanded our reach and was able to support more single mothers than ever before. We have a diversified investment strategy that puts our dollars to work in the community where single mothers are seeking support. Over this past year we continued to develop our Single Mothers Support Fund and Holiday Care Package campaign, and were also excited to re-launch our **Community Grants** funding stream with a strategic focus on supporting single mothers to achieve economic security. We research and assess programs that are effectively meeting the needs of single mothers and equipping them to provide stability for their families. This past year we invested in dozens of frontline organizations, with each dollar invested filtering up to our greater objectives of improving the economic security and personal capacity of single mothers, and ensuring their children's opportunities are not restricted by financial barriers. Thanks to the generosity of our donors and volunteers, we significantly increased our fundraising revenues and were able to grow our distributions by 80%, investing over \$625,000 in supports for single mothers. The pressures faced by single mothers continue to be enormous, and so we remain committed in their corner, doing what we can to invest in their success. The pages of this impact report will detail our work with these resilient women over the past year, and the difference your support is making in their lives.

WHAT WE DO:

WHY WE CARE

58% of children living in poverty in BC are from single parent families (2022 BC Child Poverty Report Card). There are many factors that can contribute to single mothers' poverty including gender-based pay inequity, lack of affordable childcare, lack of affordable housing, and the economic impacts of fleeing abusive relationships.

Cause We Care is the only foundation in the Lower Mainland that is solely focused on investing in and improving the lives of single mothers and their children. As the sole caregivers in their children's lives, single mothers have the motivation and the will to succeed. Cause We Care's work is in helping make the way a little bit easier for them.

THE PATH TO ECONOMIC SECURITY

In 2022 our investments supported more than 2,700 single mothers and their children across the Lower Mainland through a variety of programs and initiatives including housing programs, support groups, childcare programs, employment training and educational grants. Together, our investments support single mothers to move along the continuum of their needs to achieve improved economic security.

Our dollars are strategically invested to meet the spectrum of needs single mothers experience on their journeys to economic independence.

SINGLE MOTHERS SUPPORT FUND 2022

The Cause We Care Single Mothers Support Fund (SMSF) is a holistic fund supporting single mothers who are restricted by financial barriers yet have the resilience, desire, and determination to complete educational or job training programs to improve their economic security. Cause We Care has provided these grants to mothers pursuing a wide variety of careers, including social work, teaching, nursing and accounting. We ask recipients to report back on their outcomes one year post funding and results demonstrate the positive impact our investments have made in the lives of these special women: 97% have improved their education; 81% have improved financial security; 78% have improved mental health; 83% have improved opportunities for their children; 86% have improved connections to the community; and 94% have improved hopefulness for the future.

WHAT OUR SINGLE MOTHERS SY SUPPORT FUND RECIPIENTS SAY

This is a challenging time in my life when I have to humbly ask for help. HOLIDAY CARE PACKAGE DRIVE 2022

Cause We Care, along with our generous donors and corporate partners, has been collecting donations and delivering care packages to fill the needs of families in the Lower Mainland for the past 16 years. Ours has become the largest hamper drive in the city, with over 10,000 care packages delivered to date. In December 2022, we were proud to provide 1200 single mother-led families with a brand new backpack filled with a \$100 grocery gift card, some essential grocery supplies, warm winter accessories and a few sweet treats for the family to enjoy.
