Cause We Care Foundation envisions a world where single mothers thrive. Where they have access to safe, affordable housing and childcare allowing them to participate fully in the workforce, earn a liveable wage, and provide security to their children. Realizing this vision as a single mother in the Lower Mainland has become increasingly challenging as costs for basic needs continue to rise.

In BC, 38.3% of children living in single parent households are living in poverty, more than six times higher the poverty rate of their dual parent counterparts (2022 BC Child Poverty Report Card).

There are many factors that can contribute to single mothers' poverty including gender-based pay inequity, lack of affordable childcare, lack of affordable housing, and the economic impacts of fleeing abusive relationships.

Cause We Care is committed to helping single mothers succeed, despite the overwhelming challenges and financial pressures they face. Evidence from around the world shows that investing in mothers creates a ripple effect that benefits entire communities, not just their immediate family. These investments translate into healthier populations, safer communities and stronger economies.

With the support of our donors, we have invested in housing, childcare, education, employment, food security and essential supply programs and touched the lives of over 1900 single mother-led families this past year. We know that when critical supports are provided in a timely manner through skilled frontline organizations, single mothers can overcome challenges, unlock their potential and positively impact the world around them. When single mothers thrive, their children thrive.







#### **COMMUNITY GRANTS**


Cause We Care is committed to investing in a variety of high-quality programs in the community that improve the economic security and personal capacity of single mothers, and provide the children of single mothers with opportunities that improve their well-being. Our dollars are strategically invested to meet the spectrum of needs single mothers experience on their journeys to economic independence.

A total of \$268,000 was awarded to 13 frontline organizations in 2023.

#### SINGLE MOTHERS SUPPORT FUND

The Cause We Care Single Mothers Support Fund (SMSF) provides grants to low-income single mothers who are pursuing further education or vocational training in an effort to improve their earning potential and economic security.

Cause We Care has provided over 140 of these grants to mothers pursuing a wide variety of careers, including Human Resources, Dental Technology, Library Information and Technology, and Nursing. Recipients report back on their outcomes one year post funding and results demonstrate the positive impact our investments have made in the lives of these special women:

#### 2023 HOLIDAY CARE PACKAGE DRIVE

Cause We Care, along with our generous donors and corporate partners, has been collecting donations and delivering care packages to fill the needs of vulnerable families in the Lower Mainland for the past 17 years.

Ours has become the largest hamper drive in the city, with over 11,000 care packages delivered to date. In December 2023, we were proud to provide 1200 single mother-led families with a new backpack filled with a \$100 grocery gift card, some essential grocery supplies, warm winter accessories and some sweet treats for the family to enjoy.



# Providing Safe & Affordable Housing

Cause We Care House, operated by YWCA Metro Vancouver, continues to provide safe and affordable housing to 21 single mother-led families in the Downtown Eastside. Situated above a full-service library, residents also benefit from free on-site programming, including the Employment Navigator program which connects single mothers to resources and education during their pre-employment stage.

In 2023, Cause We Care Foundation was pleased to support the residents of Cause We Care House by funding a new boiler for the building, providing Holiday Care Packages to the 21 resident families, and funding two residents to pursue further education through our Single Mothers Support Fund.
